

International Master's Degree in New Music (Salzburg - Dresden - Bern)

Profound knowledge and skills in the field of contemporary music is increasingly becoming part of the professional requirements for musicians and singers.

The International Master of New Music is offered as a cooperative study program of the University Mozarteum Salzburg, the Hochschule für Musik Carl Maria von Weber Dresden and the Hochschule der Künste Bern and enables students to take part in a wide range of courses and to establish international professional contacts.

Students spend one academic year each at two of the cooperating universities. In addition to instrumental or vocal lessons and a focus on contemporary chamber music, the program offers experience in areas such as music theater, live electronics and improvisation. In addition, joint ensemble projects are carried out, the results of which are presented alternately at all three partner institutions.

The international master's programme is aimed at prospective students who already have a first professional degree. The prerequisite for admission to the Master's programme in New Music is the completion of a corresponding Bachelor's degree or other equivalent degree at a recognised domestic or foreign educational institution. It concludes with the "Master of Music".

The following studies are offered at the Mozarteum: voice, piano, organ, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, bass tuba, percussion, violin and violoncello
